

The Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG)

We are charged with the responsibility to publish how the Pupil Deprivation Grant (PDG) is spent and the impact of the PDG on the achievement of our most disadvantaged pupils as this is, justifiably, a high priority here in Wales. This grant apportionment are subject to the terms and conditions set out in the PDG Short guidance for practitioners as is the requirement to publish;

‘The grant does not have to be tracked to individual learners, but schools must bear in mind that they will be held accountable for how they use the grant. Estyn inspectors will be assessing how schools make use of resources to support learners who are e-FSM or LAC. Schools must also publish online their PDG allocations, targets and outcomes’.
